Topic:	Joseph and Potiphar's House				
Passage(s):		Genesis 39:1-23			
Introduction to Lesson:		Joseph is a Messianic character, foreshadowing Christ.			

Ice Breaker: Talk about an example of when God's hand was upon you even in a difficult time.

Discussion and Application:

- Point 1: **Ups and Downs**. What do you know about "prosperity gospel"? Trick question: Are good things due to God's blessing? When has God used difficulty for his good?
- Point 2: Work. Ever had a difficult boss? Ever felt like phoning it in? Who was watching? Read Matt. 25:14-30. How did Joseph's work life illustrate "working unto the Lord"?
- Point 3: **Temptation**. Read 1 Cor 10; John 8:44. How prepared are you for temptation? Read Gen 39:8,9: How did Joseph respond? Where did his conviction come from?
- Point 4: **God's Providence**. Do you believe in providence? What does providence look like? Have you ever felt falsely accused? How can you trust God's hand more in your life?

Going Deeper:

Reflection: Where do you need to better model Joseph this week: in your workplace; in preparing

a better response to temptation; in recognizing God's providence during a trial or difficult time?

List some ways Joseph reminds you of Christ.
